

POLICE ORDER No. 240

SUBJECT—Sanction of prosecution against public servants in [non-cognizable cases]

According to the revised Police Manual Rule 255, applications for prosecution in non-cognizable cases shall be made to the Magistrate through the Circle Inspector who shall forward them to the Superintendent of Police if they are of unusual nature or against public servants or when required by any law or rule. In such cases, particularly when a Government servant is involved in any non-cognizable case, the Superintendent of Police shall exercise proper discretion and if he considers it necessary consult the District level officer of the Department to which the Government servant sought to be prosecuted belongs before sanctioning prosecution.
